

Arlington MN (May 19, 2007-Despite rainshowers throughout the evening, the KARP, Crow River Customs, and Berry Cam Night at the Arlington Raceway still managed to get completed although several fans gave up and left before the program was complete. Scott Clobes from Fairfax was victorious in the Liberty Station Hobby A feature as he moved up from his 8th place start to take over the lead from Mike Westphal of Le Sueur. He stayed ahead of Todd Rossing from New Ulm for the remainder of the race and Rossing held off Chris Issacson of New Ulm to take 2nd place.

The Blue Sky Creamery WISSOTA Midwest Modified feature saw two different leaders as Andrew Schuelke of Howard Lake held onto his pole position start until Darrell Torgerson of Mankato moved through the field from his 12th place start. Once he got in the lead, he stayed there as Tyler Limoges of Redwood Falls tried to take over the race but settled for 2nd ahead of Schuelke.

The Annhilator IMCA Stock Car feature was exciting with two different leaders. Todd Sterner of Howard Lake led the first 14 laps but lost the lead when he spun out in turn #4, he eventually retired to the pit area. Tom Suess from New Ulm then got by him starting in 9th place and taking over the lead by the 15th lap. Dan Mackenthun from Hamburg then battled with Suess to try to take over the race, but he had to settle for 2nd ahead of Shaun Bruns of Olivia.

Mike Sargent of Cleveland led the entire distance of the U.S. ARMY IMCA Sprint feature to take his first win of the year. There was a yellow flag at the start of the race when the cars of Jenny Eriksen, Brett Allen and Brandon Allen all got tangled and ended up in the pit area with damage to each car. Jesse Smith of Mankato took the 2nd place spot ahead of Keith Beckler of Litchfield.

The 93 KXLP IMCA Modified feature was led by Damon Haslip of Waseca the entire distance to win his first feature of the year. On lap 3 there was a multi car crash on lap 4. Several cars went into the work area at that time. On the restart, Haslip took off again with Darrell Torgerson of Mankato trying to get by him but did all he could to hold off Paul Burger of Belle Plaine to take 2nd ahead of Burger.

The Yellow Book Hobby B feature was run during the rain from start to finish. Joe Maas of Howard Lake looked as though he was going to win his first event ever but as the track got slipier he lost a little traction and the Joe Pomerer of Litchfield got by him to take over the lead but he also lost momentum going into turn #3 as Ben Enter of slid by both cars to take over the lead and win the event.
