Arlington, MN (June 9, 2007)-The Liberty Station Hobby A feature had 21 cars the event. Jordan Robb from Nicollet led 11 laps of the 20 lap race doing a great job until Brad Roepke of New Germany got by him to take the lead away. A yellow flag occurred on lap 9 when the cars of Joe Maas and Dave Moriarity got tangled in turn #2 causing both cars to go to the pit area for the evening. Roepke then got the lead after the restart and held off Robb for the win.

The Blue Sky Creamery Midwest Modified feature also had 20 cars start the race. Dan Menk of Franklin led the first 4 laps of the race then Darrell Torgerson of Mankato got around him after starting in 4th place. Despite a yellow flag on lap 14, Torgerson still held off Dan Menk to win the race. Randy Schumm of Rogers took 3rd place. In heat race action Tyler Limoges of Redwood Falls started last and at the drop of the green flag he got to the front of the pack at the start of the race by the first turn.

The Annihilator IMCA Stock Car feature had 24 cars begin the race and their event was cut short due to time limits. Shawn Jakes of New Ulm was the early leader with Joe Voss of Belle Plaine in 2nd. A caution was thrown on lap 6 when John Polifka of Glencoe spun out due to a tire malfunction. On the restart another yellow flag occurred when the car of Tory Harazin had problems. Another restart occurred and then the 87 got pushed up into the #4 causing him to malfunction and go into the pit area for the night. After this restart, Tom Suess of New Ulm was leading the race and held on for the win ahead of Dan Mackenthun of Hamburg and Jakes held on for 3rd place.

The U.S. ARMY IMCA Sprints had problems at the start of the first heat race when Shannon Ericksen came down in the mud and got tangled up in traffic causing 3 cars to end their race. At feature time, Luther Roberts of Mankato led the first lap of the race until Mike Sargent of Cleveland moved past the first 4 cars to take the lead. There was only one yellow flag when the car of Dan Grams expired on the front stretch causing a yellow flag. That didn't slow Sargent down at all as he led the remaining laps to win the race ahead of Brandon Allen of St. Peter and Bill Johnson of St. Peter took 3rd.

The 93 KXLP IMCA Modified feature was also cut short due to time limitations. Damon Haslip of Waseca led the entire event from start to finish ahead of Darrell Torgerson of Mankato. Jeff Coon of Elysian took 3rd place.

The Yellow Book Hobby B feature saw Jason Wills from Glencoe start by leading the race but he fell back after spinning off the track. Then Matt Schauer of Glencoe took over the race but he too spun out on his own in turn #2 giving the lead to Ben Enter of New Ulm. Enter then led the remaining laps of the race ahead of Corey Schultz and Brad Robinson.
