

Redwood Falls, MN-May 13, 2007-There was some fantastic racing action as the Redwood Speedway opened up for the season. Twenty Nelson Towing Bomber cars all wanted to take home the trophy as they worked furiously for the 20 lap extravaganza. Jason Firlie of Fairfax took the early lead but soon last year's track champion Mark Clobes of Fairfax was in command of the race. He fell off the pace with mechanical problems eventually sending him into the pit. On lap 12 Terry Anderson of Springfield took the lead with West Hustad of Belview who had started in pole position taking 2nd ahead of Lyle Heiderscheidt who started last and was able to stay out of trouble to take 3rd place.

Returning to the Redwood Speedway after a long hiatus was Scott Clobes of Fairfax in the Liberty Station Hobby A's. He and Tim Pessek from Hutchinson fought each other the entire distance but with only a couple laps left, Clobes got around Pessek to take the win from him. Newcomer George Motto from St. Peter took 3rd place.

The Blue Sky Creamery WISSOTA Midwest Modified feature was an awesome event with fender to fender racing throughout. Jesse Trebil of Atwater bolted from his front row start; he held onto the lead for the first 10 laps but then Brandon Nelson of New London got around him and also held off Dominick Gregorie of Cottonwood to win the race. Gregorie and Tyler Limoges of Redwood Falls raced neck and neck throughout but Limoges had to settle for 3rd.

It looked as if Aaron Wisch of Arlington was going to win the Annihilator IMCA Stock feature as he led almost the entire distance but he had some tough competition and with only a few laps to go, Dan Mackenthun of Hamburg got around Wisch to take the lead and win. Wisch held on for 2nd as Shane Bruns of Olivia and Rick Mees of Eagle fought for the 3rd spot with Bruns overcoming Mees.

The U.S. ARMY IMCA Sprint feature was all Jesse Smith of Mankato as he led the flag to flag race the entire distance. He worked around lapped traffic just ahead of Mike Sargent of Cleveland. Bill Johnson of St. Peter took 3rd place.

The 93 KXLP IMCA Modified feature saw three different leaders. Jeff Maasch of Vesta looked as though he had the race sewed up but going into the third turn on lap 13, his car locked up causing him to spin out and go into the pit. On the restart, Chad Porter of Madison Lake took over the front spot with Tim Wertish of Redwood Falls who had started 11th and stayed out of trouble was soon upon Porter. As they were coming out of turn #4 on the 15th lap, Porter got too high and Wertish dove under him to take the lead and win the race. Porter took 2nd and Andy Timm of Mankato took 3rd place.
