

Redwood Falls, MN (July 15, 2007)-NAPA Auto Parts of Redwood Falls and Sleepy Eye hosted a great night of racing action at the Redwood Speedway. Jayson Firlie of Fairfax outlasted the outrageous and wild Nelson Towing Bomber cars to win the 20 lap feature ahead of Terry Anderson of Springfield. In post race techng, Anderson was disqualified for illegal parts giving the 2nd place to Wesley Hustad of Belview. Shane Heiderscheidt of Sleepy Eye took 3rd place.

Shane Harazin of New Ulm picked up his first feature win of the season in the Liberty Station Hobby A. He led the race for the first 6 laps and then Adam Ecker of Comfrey took the lead but he spun out in turn #4 after two laps and then the lead went back to Harazin for the remaining 7 laps to win the event. Tim Pessek of Hutchinson took 2nd and Patrick Kohn of Hutchinson took 3rd place.

Tyler Limoges of Redwood Falls led the WISSOTA Midwest Modified feature from start to finish commanding the race ahead of Dan Menk of Franklin. Matt Deering of Spicer took 3rd place.

Wally Hustad of Belview started in the front row of the Annihilator IMCA Stock car feature and he too took command of the race on the first lap and led the entire event to win the race. Mike Bruns of Olivia moved up from his 5th place start to gain on Hustad but he settled for 2nd ahead of brother Shane.

In the U.S. ARMY IMCA Sprint feature it looked as though Jason Tostenson from Gaylord was going to make it two in a row for the Jackpot Junction IMCA Sprint series race but lap by lap, Curt Lund who was suppose to start up front went to the work area on the parade lap and came back out to start the race in 18th place and he picked off car by car to battle with Tostenson with only a few laps left in the race. He got by him to win, Tostenson took 2nd and Donavin Peterson of Watertown, SD took 3rd place ahead of Bill Johnson of St. Peter. Dan Menk of Franklin led the first two laps of the race and then Tostenson got by him on the third lap. A yellow flag was thrown on lap 7 when the car of Nate Laugen from Lake Mills, Iowa spun around in turn \$4, he was able to resume the race but as the checkered flag was being thrown, his engine expired.

The KXLP IMCA Modified race was won by John Klugherz of Mankato who managed to stay ahead of hard runner Curt Lund of Redwood Falls the entire distance. Chad Porter of Madison Lake was the early leader but after a yellow came out for a spinning Tim Wertish in turn #2, Klugherz took the lead and never looked back. There was a mult car crash on lap 4 when Andy Timm of Mankato spun around causing a chain reaction behind him. That put Timm and Mike Gregg of Redwood Falls into the pit. After that, the race went green for the remaining laps with Klugherz holding off Lund and Porter taking 3rd ahead of Paul Burger of Belle Plaine.
