

Redwood Falls, MN (July 29, 2007)-There was a beautiful night for racing at the Redwood Speedway for the Redwood Building Center Night. The only new winner in victory lane was Adam Ecker from Comfrey, he gained the lead in the Liberty Station Hobby A event after Rod Manthey from Norwood got squirrely coming out of turn #4 and Ecker got around him to take the lead on lap 8. Manthey lost 2 positions when Patrick Kohn of Hutchinson also got by him. Kohn tried to gain on Ecker but Ecker wasn't giving up and ran hard to the checkered flag to claim his first win of the season. Kohn took 2nd and Manthey took 3rd ahead of Tim Pessek of Hutchinson.

Monte Heiderscheidt from Sleepy Eye led the Nelson Towing Bomber feature after the first lap which took several tries to get in. First there was a yellow flag when Matt Speckman of Sleepy Eye spun in turn #4, then after the restart a red flag came out when Randy Fischer of Sleepy Eye rolled his car coming out of turn #4 in his new car he had out for the night after rolling his car last week in the same spot. After the race restarted Monte led the remaining laps to win the race ahead of Jason Firlie of Fairfax and Wade Hustad of Belview. Shawn Kruggel of Winthrop had his best finish taking 4th place.

There was three different leaders in the WISSOTA Blue Sky Creamery Midwest Modified feature with Matt Deering of Spicer taking the early lead ahead of Mark Oftedahl of Hanley Falls. Oftedahl got by Deering after a caution flag on lap 5 for a spinning car. He remained the leader for the next 10 laps but Tyler Limoges of Redwood Falls working from his 8th place start was moving quick and got around both Oftedahl and Deering to take the lead for the last 3 laps of the race. With only 2 laps to go, Bill Foesch of Olivia smoothly passed Oftedahl to take 2nd place ahead of Oftedahl and Deering settled for 4th.

The Annihilator IMCA Stock car feature was once again a close tight match. Gary Mattison of Lambertton looked as if he had the race sewed up leading from the start but a late race caution came out when the 1v car of Joe Voss from Belle Plaine spun in turn #2 and on the restart, Mattison held on until the 4th turn when Shaun Bruns of Danube took the high side around him to take the lead for the last two laps and go onto win the race. Mattison remained in 2nd ahead of Tory Harazin of Morgan.

The U.S. ARMY IMCA sprint feature saw Troy Manteufel of St. Peter get off to a commanding lead for the first 5 laps until a caution came out for Luther Roberts of Mankato who had spun in turn #2. On the restart, Troy remained the leader but Curt Lund of Redwood Falls was once again on the move and got around Manteufel on the 8th lap. On lap 7, another caution was thrown when the car of A.J. Steven's from Bingham Lake also spun in turn #2 and Manteufel spun in turn #4 at the same time. On the restart, Lund dominated the race ahead of Dwain Wilmes of Kasota with Brett Allen of Kasota moving from his 6th place start to battle with Wilmes but he settled for 3rd place ahead of Jesse Smith of Mankato.

The 93 KXLP IMCA Modified feature saw Tim Wertish and Curt Lund of Redwood Falls battle for the lead throughout the 20 lap feature. Wertish came out the winner by a quarter of a lap ahead of Lund. Paul Burger of Belle Plaine took 3rd place ahead of Mike Gregg of Redwood Falls.
